LPG WITHDRAWS FROM TAMALE CENTRAL BY-ELECTION IN HONOR OF LATE MP AND AMID POLITICAL INSTABILITY

The Liberal Party of Ghana (LPG) extends its deepest condolences to the family, constituents, and colleagues of the late Member of Parliament for Tamale Central. His passing is a profound loss to the constituency and to our nation.

In recognition of his dedicated service and as a mark of respect, the Liberal Party of Ghana has taken the decision to withdraw from participating in the upcoming Tamale Central by-election. This decision is made both in solidarity with the mourning period and in view of the current political instability in the country, which calls for unity, calm, and constructive engagement rather than heightened political contest.
